CPA Transportation

Busses will drop off and pick up students at the east end of the school and all bus students are to use the east (high school) entrance. Students who are dropped off and picked up by personal vehicle are to use the sidewalk by the main entrance or the visitor's parking at the west end of the school. High school students are to use the high school (east) entrance and elementary students are to use the elementary (west) entrance. Our goal is separate bus and vehicle traffic to ensure student safety.

Please remember to heed speed limit signs when coming into or leaving the school property.

Safe Arrival - Safe School

For safety reasons, we will be accounting for all student absences. **Please call the school office if your child will be absent.** If we have not been notified we will check on daily absences by phone. Staff supervision duty begins at 8:25 am each day, therefore students should not arrive at the school before 8:25 am.

It is also important that all visitors and parents sign in at the office. For this reason, we ask that parents and visitors enter the school through the main, front entrance. A sign-in sheet is at the front desk.

Students Leaving the Premises

High school students planning to leave the school grounds at any time during school hours must sign out at the office when leaving and sign in upon returning. Elementary students will need a note from a parent or guardian.

We are looking for a maximum of 9 people who are willing to serve in this manner (a minimum of 3 representing the high school and 3 representing the elementary).

Please note that the School Council is separate from the CPA Board. The CPA Board oversees Christian Parents' Association matters, including fundraising to run the SCAP facility and seeks to further Christian education throughout the Rainy River District.

According to the RRDSB School Council Handbook, school councils "are able to make recommendations to their principals and school boards on any matter. Principals and school boards, in turn, must consult with school councils on a variety of matters that affect student learning. They must also consider recommendations made by school councils and report back to the councils on how they plan to act on their advice. New regulations were created that confirm the advisory role of school councils and clearly state that their purpose is to improve student achievement and enhance the accountability of the education system to parents/guardians. This regulation also clarifies the role of the school councils and establishes their right to express their views on any SCHOOL-WIDE issues that are important to them."

School Councils are required to meet a minimum of four times during the school year. The first meeting is set for Wednesday, **October 2**, 6:00 pm at SCAP. Please consider getting involved in this important role! A School Council Handbook is available if you would like more information.
